

PROJECT PLANNING

24.October 2017 at 10 a.m until 19 p.m. Led by Lianne, supported by other leaders.

Participants divided into 4 groups, in each groups were participants from four different youth group, also boys and girls. Four groups named themselves Yellow Submarine, Pokemon, Blue, Kärpsed Mooch. Each folded for their group a different color button to play.

Participants ran the dice and moved steps up to 50. After each turn they had to find the number in the building or outside, make recognizable photo of this number with characteristic to identify their group. After the photo was shown, group got a question about the project. So they could prepare their own project. There were totally 27 questions to each group, but all of them were not given, depending on the topics. Questions were like 1) What new knowledge you would like to get about using your mother tongues? OR 12) how young people should be involved to running the activity?

Participants said in the end that questions were too difficult for them to understand. Although youth workers were there to support and help to understand the questions. Also the game leader explained the questions to the group.



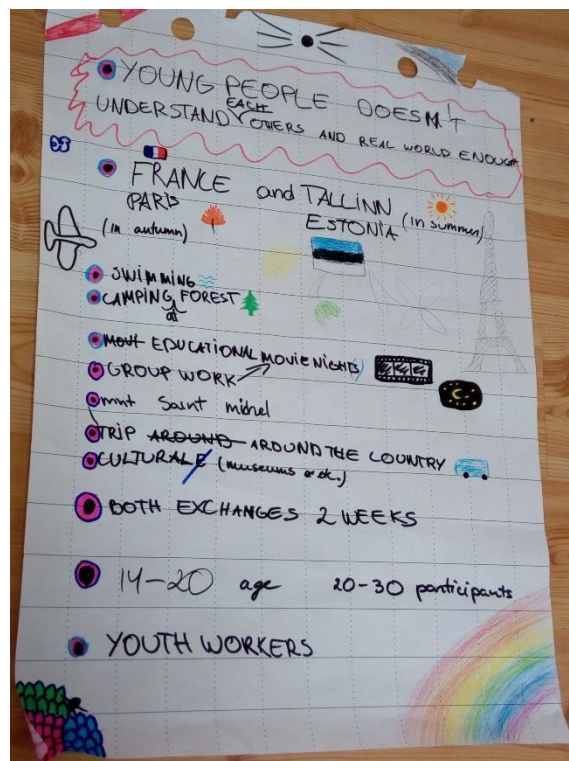
The team Yellow Submarine offered **The Recycle Green Travel Project**:



- Main topic is recycling, Green travelling, nature and the city.
- Participating countries are Estonia, France and Netherlands.
- Participants will be in age 15 to 19.
- The project is organized by youth workers, but young people help leaders to organize.
- Activities last for 7 days.
- Activities include visiting junk yards, discussions about recycling problems.

Team Pokemon proposed the **Understanding the Others Project**, flyers were shared to listeners:

- Project is needed to learn to understand better each other and world around you. Different group activities will help participants to be more open-minded. Because young people doesn't understand each other and real world enough.
- Activities would take place in Tallinn (Estonia) in summer time, and in Paris (France) at autumn, both exchanges last for two weeks.
- Participants would be young people in age 14 to 20, who want to participate, and learn to understand better each other and world around you. Participants 20 to 30.
- Activities also include group work, tripping around the countries, educational movie nights, swimming, camping at forest, mnt Saint Michel, cultural activities (museums etc).
- Participation is for free.

- Project would be organized by youth workers.



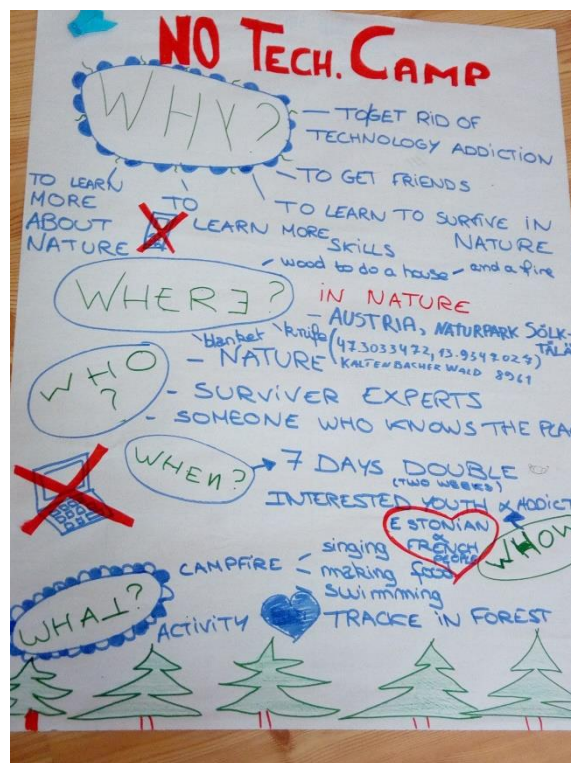
Team Blue prepare **Filmmaking Project**:



- Project is needed to show more about unspeakable truths and tales of country stayed in.
- The activity takes place in a big house, which has a sport room, and in different countries.
- Project will be organized by Cinema students between age 20 to 40, for example.
- Activity takes place in the middle of summer, 23rd of June.
- Participants will be 18 to 30 years old people, who are willing to take part.
- Activity includes theatre, museum about the city, city game (to be familiar with).

Kärpsed Mooch team offered **NO Tech. Camp Project**:

- The project is needed to get rid of technology addiction, to get friends, to learn to survive in nature, to learn more skills, and to learn more about nature.
- The activity would take place in nature in Austria in Naturpark Sölk-tälär (47.3033472, 13.9547027, Kaltenbacher Wald 8961). The wood to do a house, and a fire, and knife and blanket are needed.
- Organizers will be surviving experts and someone, who knows the place.
- The activity lasts double of 7 days (two weeks totally).
- Participants will be interested youth and addicted on technology. Estonian and French people.
- The activity will include campfire (singing, making food, swimming), tracing in forest.



Groups were mixed, and new four groups were formulated. Participants took another role by lottery. Each group represented one stakeholders group – young people, parents, youth worker, foundation (Erasmus+). Groups had to make decision, which project they would support, based on the values of each stakeholder discussed before.

As a results young people would choose The Movie Making Project, parents would choose the Understanding the Others Project, youth workers would choose NO Tech. Camp Project, and Foundation would support Recycling Green Travel Project. The group concluded, that it's not an easy task to compose a project, what would like to each part, but we can try on that.
